Owlets £4

Owlets is run every day. This is a club aimed at those children who don't always wish to participate in a club that is structured or too energetic. This club will have a different focus activity each day, whether it is Lego based activities, playdough, board games, drawing activities or occasionally playing educational games on the iPad. The staff members will read with children and when possible the children can play outside in the adventure playground.

Homework club £6

Monday: KS2 (Years 3-5)/Thursday: KS1 (Years 1 and 2)

This is a club run by a qualified teacher and a teaching assistant, where they can help your child with their homework set each week by the class teacher. They have the time to sit and

practice their spellings set that week. They will also read their reading book with an adult too, this will improve their reading skills and further their comprehension/understanding as they will discuss the book they are reading.

Nutritional Ninjas (Years 2 and 3) £8.50

Nutritional Ninjas is a club run by external providers, therefore this is reflected in the cost of the club. The teacher provides all the ingredients for the food and equipment, all your child may need to bring in is a Tupperware box to bring food home in. Bollywood Dance Club £6

Bollywood Dance Club is for all year groups, run by a professional Bollywood Dancer. The children will have fun practising dance routines and will do an end of term show for parents.

Netball £6

Netball club is a great opportunity for all years to improve on their netball skills. In netball club we will incorporate, the fundamental skills of any ball sport as well as being able to push the boundaries for the more advanced. This is a great opportunity for all ages and will be great preparation for future events. PE kit to be worn.

Gymnastics £6

The children will be working on different floor based gymnastic skills. Gymnastics works the fundamental physical skills that all children need to develop to become fit, healthy and active, including; strength, flexibility, coordination, balance, stamina, power and core stability. Please wear practical clothing.

Karate £6

Monday: Beginners-lower grades/Wednesday: Higher grades- Orange/yellow+
We are affiliated with TISKA karate club who will give children the opportunity to take part in karate grading outside of school time and work their way through the various belts. Split into two sessions: Mondays for beginners and lower grades, Wednesdays (by invitation only) for higher grades.

Tag Rugby (KS2) £6

This is for girls and boys to learn different skills in a rugby based context that can be applied in a wider range of sports. School PE kit must be worn.

Dodge Ball (KS2) £6

“There are five D’s in Dodgeball, Dodge, Duck, Dip, Dive and Dodge” and in this club we will work on all five. This will be a great opportunity to play a new sport, which also incorporates the essential skills of throwing and catching. Open to all years but will be separated into appropriate year groups. PE kit must be worn.

Football (KS2) £6

Football is open to both boy’s and girl’s and will cover a range from basic skills to advance patterns of play. No shin pads/studs required. Suitable clothing must be worn.

iMovie Maker £6

In this club the children will work together on different projects using ‘iMovie’.



Little Tanks Drama £6

Run by Little Tanks - a fun drama club that aims to build confidence within the children for them to use the skills they develop in their day to day routine. Each session the tutor will carry out activities that will help encourage the children’s confidence as well as working towards a small-scale production at the end of the term.



Running Club (year 3-5) £6

Running club will be for anyone interested in running at any level, from those that aspire to be Mo Farah to those looking to try it for the first time. Each week we will start with a dynamic warm up, followed by either a group run or interval training. We will be making the most of beautiful new surroundings, but mostly importantly, we will have fun!
