

SRE Curriculum

At Braywick Court School, we believe in providing a broad and balanced curriculum for our pupils that also involves a comprehensive RSE (relationships and sex education) scheme of work. SRE lessons will be taught during the second part of the summer term from EYFS up to year 6 and will follow the Christopher Winter Project resource 'Teaching SRE with Confidence in Primary Schools'. This programme reflects the recent developments in RSE and the Science National Curriculum and has been quality assured by the PSHE Association.

The aim of SRE is not only to ensure children are well informed about the changes their bodies go through during puberty but also focuses on safeguarding/keeping children safe. The lessons also encourage children to develop the skills of listening, empathy, talking about feelings and relationships with families and friends.
